

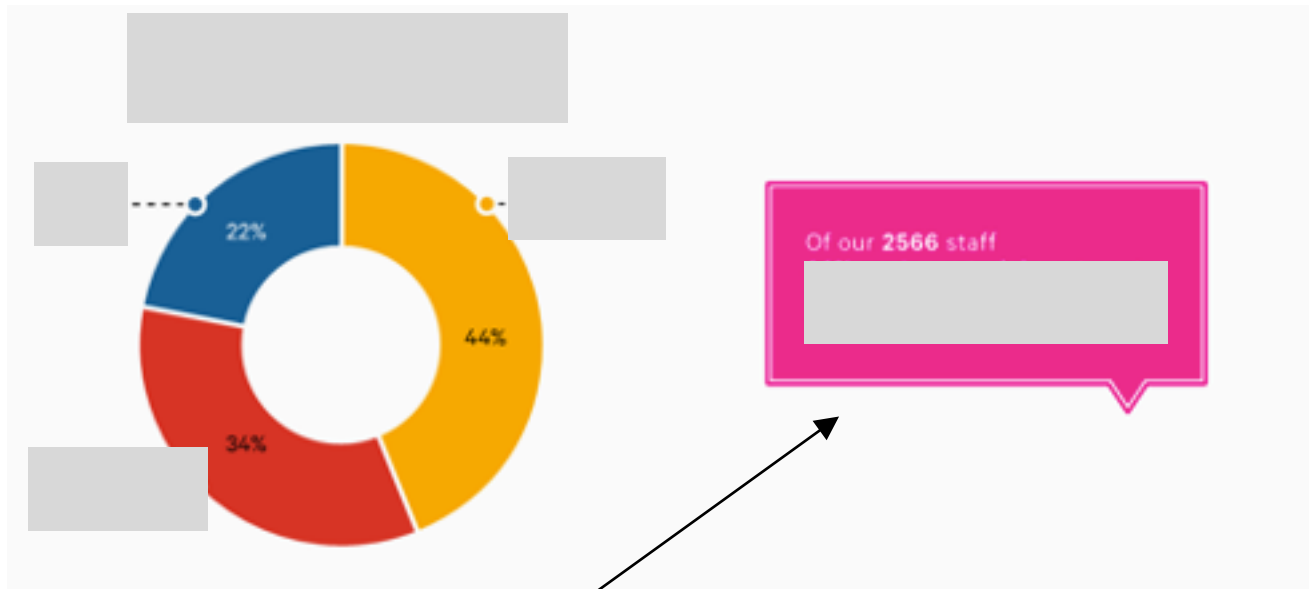

p. 6-7 - Alt text for images

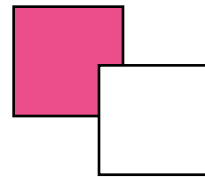
p. 9 - Alt text and captions for campus images (rather than titles in the images).

p. 9-10 - Check table heading - make sure that header is repeated on page break.



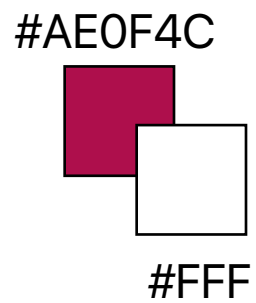

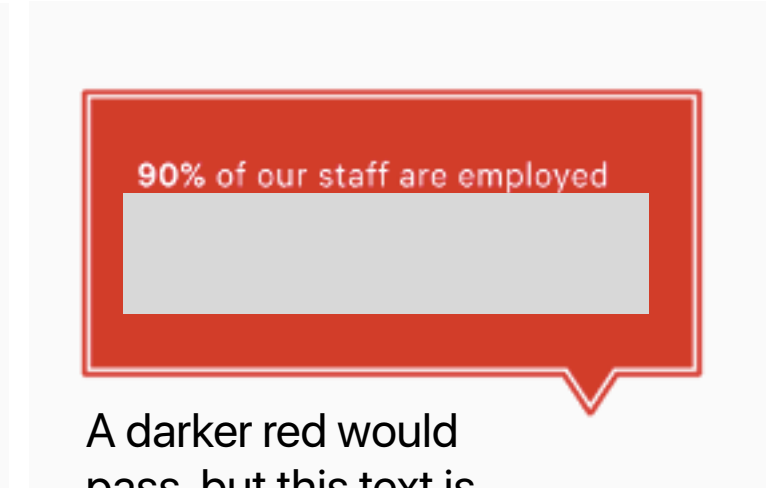
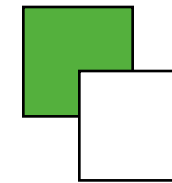


p. 11 - contrast revision recommended. Also 'male' is red in this viz whereas typically red is used for 'female' although the colour scheme needs to be revised overall.

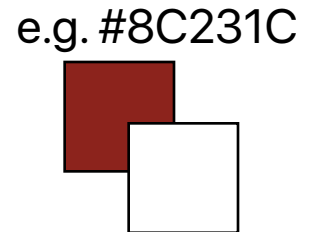
ALL the boxes of text presented as images needs to have the text as alt text.



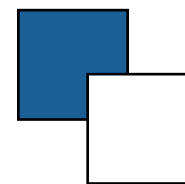
If this text were black this box would pass AAA. The white text fails contrast tests.



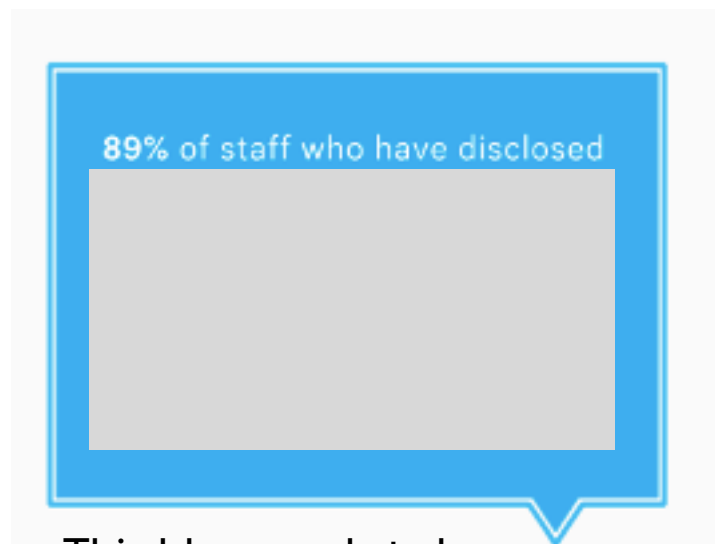
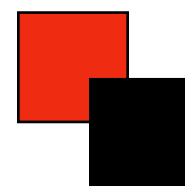
A darker red would pass, but this text is still very small to make out. A lighter red with black text might be better.
